MEET THE NFL VENDORS WORKSHOP

Throughout June, Business Connect hosted our *Meet the Vendors* workshop series. Born out of the COVID-19 business disruptions leading up to SBLV in Tampa, this virtual workshop series offers an opportunity to hear directly from the NFL vendors in charge of procurement for Super Bowl contracts.

The series kicked off this year with our Caterers as we brought five of the NFL vendors (PPW, BaAm, 1Team, Landmark, and OnLocation) and all 88 of the Business Connect catering suppliers together to talk *food and beverage* for Super Bowl LVII. The vendors spoke frankly about their catering needs this year, what Super Bowl events their teams were in charge of, and the procurement process. As with all of the Meet the Vendor workshops, extra time was spent discussing the details of the ITB/RFP/contracting process. Each vendor handles this in a slightly different way but hopefully, it was helpful to hear some tips and best practices for navigating Super Bowl procurement.

The workshop series also included sessions for Event Production, Staffing & Contract Labor, General Contracting & Trades, Security, and Signage.

Cristine Paull, of SP+ GAMEDAY, was thrilled to join us again this year for the Staffing workshop. In speaking with her after the panel, Cristine told us "we always look forward to the Meet the Vendors workshop every year. I am glad that we were able to do it virtually and provide the suppliers with a snapshot of our operations. SP+ GAMEDAY feels lucky to participate in the program because we have made some long-lasting relationships with suppliers that have carried over to other (non-NFL) operations."

Other vendors mirrored Cristine's excitement and shared their eagerness to dive into the RFP process and explore the amazing talent that Arizona and Business Connect have to offer.

In-person Business Connect Supplier Workshop: How to Write an Effective RFP Response


