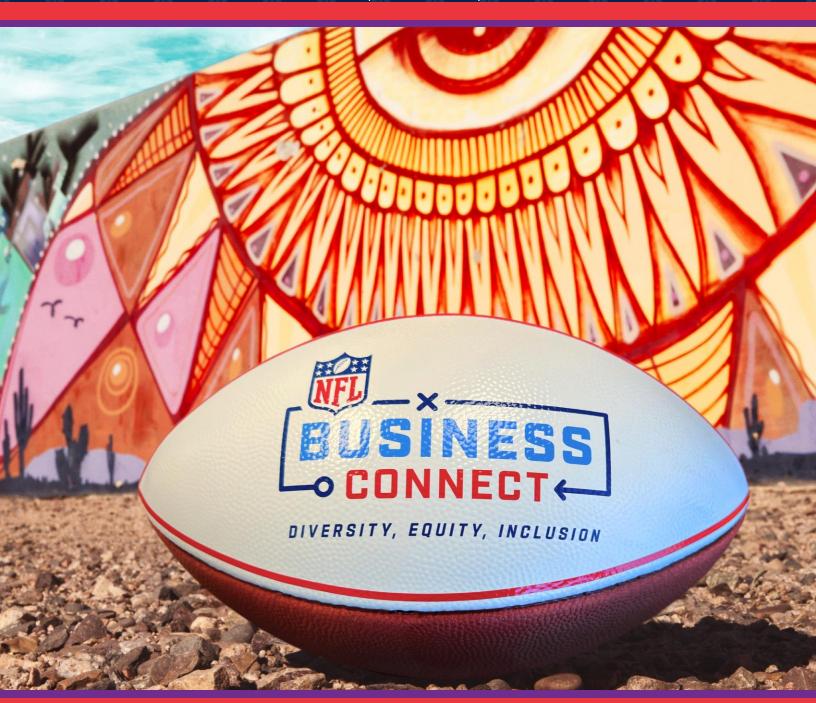

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PRO TIPS

How to write an Effective RFP Response

Here are our favorite takeaways

Best Practices:

- Read the RFP thoroughly. Make a checklist of everything the document asks you to answer or attach to your submission.
- Be responsive to calls and emails from your contact during the RFP and job process.
- If you have questions about the RFP, send them to your vendor. They will answer your questions.
- Send your RFP response in BEFORE the deadline missing materials or deadlines will get you eliminated from consideration.

Things to Think About When Responding to an RFP:

- Keep a marketing mindset when applying for an RFP. Marketing is selling. It teaches you to tell your story about what differentiates your products and services from others.
- Apply for certifications. Some contractors give points to certified companies during the evaluation process.
- The lowest-priced bid is not always the winning bid. All companies are looking for good partners. Incomplete bids are always rejected.

From the Business Connect Team

We are excited to see our Business Connect Suppliers receiving contracts! If you have not yet been contacted for a contract – DO NOT WORRY! This is only the beginning, and we have gathered up some tips & tricks to help your chances of securing a contract:

Do not let voicemails sit in your voicemail box for more than a day. To receive a contract opportunity, you must be ready to call back and say "YES!" Don't let an opportunity fly by just because you missed a call and didn't call back.

Clean out your voicemail box regularly. Time and time again, contract opportunities are missed simply because we can't get the great news to suppliers! Make sure to clear out all unnecessary spam voicemails and leave some room to receive an exciting opportunity!

Keep your websites updated. Every month or so, have a friend or an employee go to your website and click through every page. Make sure none of the links are broken (social media links, page navigation, etc.).

If you need to partner with another company to complete an event, notify your contract point of contact immediately. Event production for Super Bowl is an exercise in teamwork. Everyone needs to communicate and deliver their part of the event on time and at the highest quality

Any RFP you respond to is one piece of a multi-supplier mosaic that involves a lot of suppliers representing various business lines and moving pieces that will eventually come together to produce one event.



The NFL has created a special use logo for Business Connect suppliers that allows member companies to showcase their association with the Business Connect program. The "Supplier Logo" is the ONLY logo Business Connect suppliers are legally allowed to use. All other NFL, Super Bowl, Arizona Cardinals and Host Committee logos are copyright protected. Additionally, all marks associated with Super Bowl, including the Lombardi Trophy, the Wilson Football, images of State Farm Stadium, the words Super Bowl and the corresponding roman numerals are all copyright protected and CANNOT BE USED by anyone, including Business Connect suppliers.

Business Connect suppliers are encouraged to use the previously provided decal to put on your storefront window, a mirror inside of the business or on your personal company vehicle.
